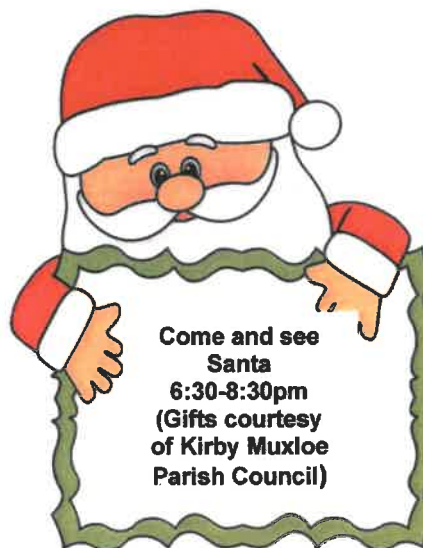

Cooper is a 5-year old boy who is allergic to nuts and legumes (peanuts, lentils, chickpeas, peas, beans, lupin etc.) The family are raising money for a new, specialised medical kit for our local Primary School.

The kit contains life-saving Epi-Pens as well as offering accessible training for all school staff. Providing access to anaphylaxis kits in schools could save a child's life in an emergency situation as sometimes treating anaphylaxis requires multiple shots of adrenaline.

The medical kit costs £650 per year for 5-years (£3,250.00 total). Anything we raise at the Christmas Light Switch On Event will be donated to Cooper's family to go towards purchasing this medical equipment.
