Members were reminded that the contractor who initially believed the rocking horse could be restored, has since confirmed this is not an

option. The results of the Facebook consultation were presented, which reflected the 'Rota Bounce' as the preferred replacement at a cost of £5312.40.

It was **RESOLVED** that the 'Rota Bounce' replaces the rocking horse.

ii. A quotation/s for hedge reduction by the Sports Pavilion, as a result of vandalism

A quotation to reduce the hedge by the sports pavilion was presented.

After some discussion, it was **RESOLVED** that CCTV quotations be obtained for this area.

The lighting in the Recreation Ground was noted.


