1. Chairman's Welcome and apologies

The Chairman welcomed all to the first Annual Parish Meeting in two years, which due to not being quorate at 7 p.m., commenced at 7:20 p.m.

2. Minutes of the Parish Meeting held on Tuesday 16th May 2019

Access to the draft minutes could not be gained due to the file on the system being unrecoverable and the notes not being present in the file.

3. Chairman's Report (2019-21)

The Chairman reported that there is now a tenant at The Byways, following the renovation works.

The maintenance programme for the 'pond' was noted, as was the purpose for this area.

It was noted that sadly due to covid restrictions, the last time the Christmas Lights Switch On event took place was two years ago and staff changes were also highlighted.

Transferring Recreation Ground Charity land to the Primary School was reported to be ongoing, with advice awaited from the Charity Commission and assisting Kirby Muxloe Library & Community Hub with the lease was also noted.

A grant application for the War Memorial Project has been submitted, but works cannot commence until this has been considered.

Waterlogged ground, known to be 'washland' near the Cricket Pavilion is proving to be an issue, but this is currently being monitored.

The much-loved rocking horse has been reported as a risk in the Annual RoSPA Report, which if even possible, would take some considerable work to restore. The public are to be consulted on this. However, a new basket swing has recently been provided.

The administration burden associated with the Cemetery, Allotments, Castle Road Car Park, Meetings, etc was also reiterated.

This was included in the Chairmans Report.

- ii. Planning Committee**
The Chairman of the Planning Committee detailed that Planning has been fraught with difficulties and suggestions for addressing planning matters going forward are to be considered at a forthcoming meeting.
