It was requested that advice be sought from the Charity Commission and Blaby District Council in the first instance
  - ii      Brambles and branches being cut back in the Recreation Ground**  
It was noted that two contractors have viewed the bramble situation and while one considered this futile, agreed to provide a quotation. The other contractor declined.

PROPOSED by Cllr J E John and SECONDED by Cllr C Frost

It was **RESOLVED** to trim the brambles twice a year.

A branch considered to enable easier access to the school was noted, but it was **AGREED** that no further action be taken



**iii A resident's fence reported to have been damaged by a tree in the Play Area**

PROPOSED by Cllr C Frost and SECONDED by D Everley

In view of the situation, it was **RESOLVED** that Council offer to pay 50% towards the cost of a like for like replacement fence.

**iv The trees lining the path in the Recreation Ground**

It was highlighted that the 12-14 trees lining the path were planted to commemorate those who fell at War. However, due to decay, a tree on school land has recently been felled and a resident has therefore questioned whether this will be replaced. Due to some uncertainty around the number of trees, it was **AGREED** to liaise with the History Group in the first instance.
