iii A resident's fence reported to have been damaged by a tree in the Play Area

In view of the situation, it was **RESOLVED** that Council offer to pay 50% towards the cost of a like for like replacement fence.

iv The trees lining the path in the Recreation Ground

It was highlighted that the 12-14 trees lining the path were planted to commemorate those who fell at War. However, due to decay, a tree on school land has recently been felled and a resident has therefore questioned whether this will be replaced. Due to some uncertainty around the number of trees, it was AGREED to liaise with the History Group in the first instance.
